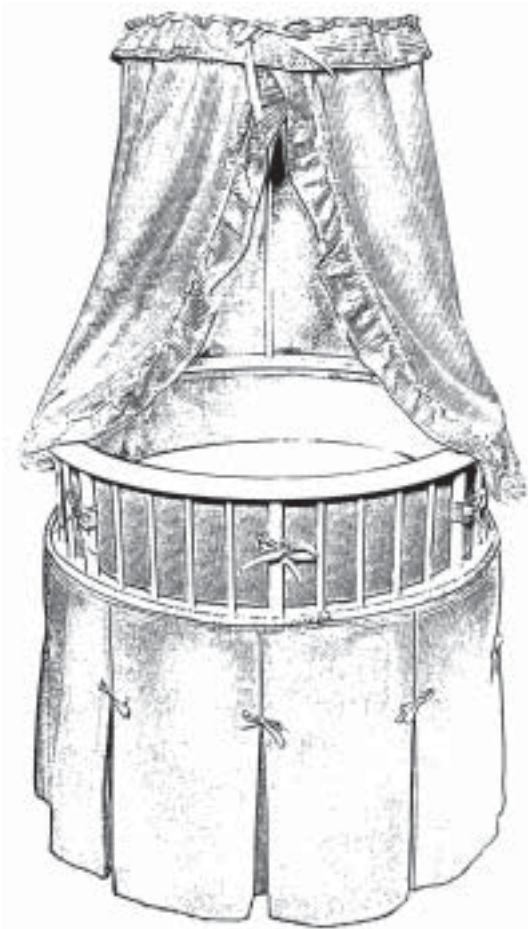

### TOOLS NEEDED:

Phillips Screwdriver

Pliers

Hammer

*Power screwdriver is helpful but be careful not to damage the bassinet.*

(A) 2 - End Panels

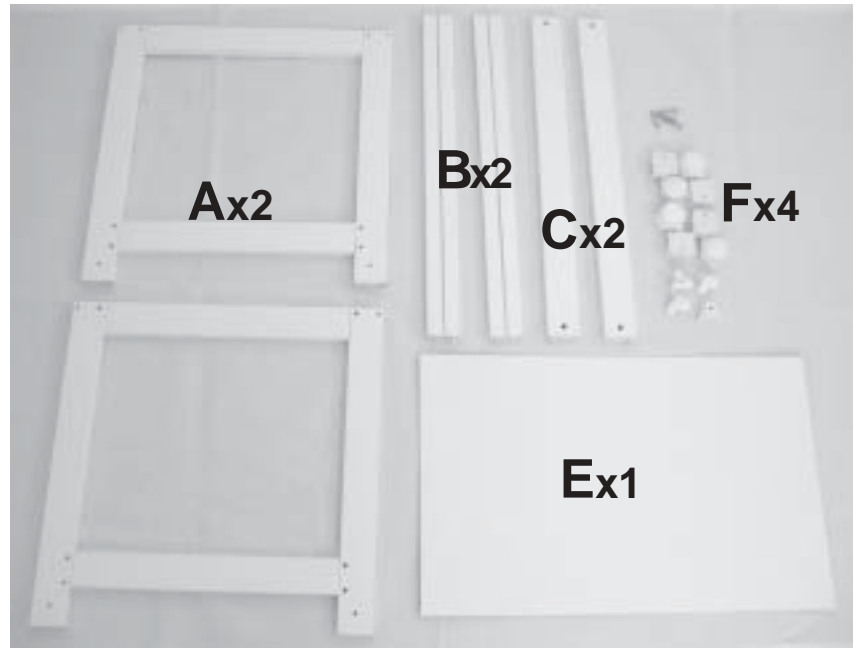
(B) 2 - Bottom Rails w/ Grooves

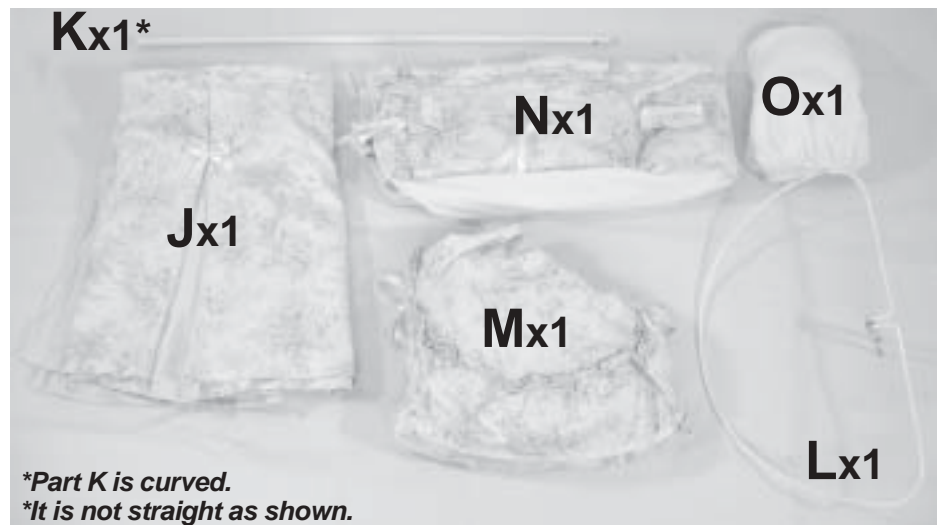

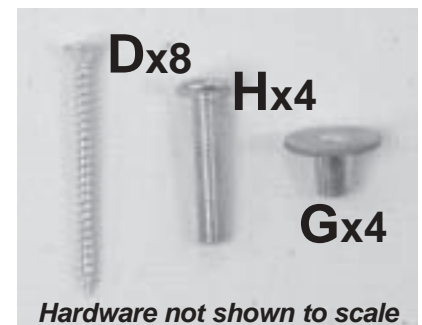

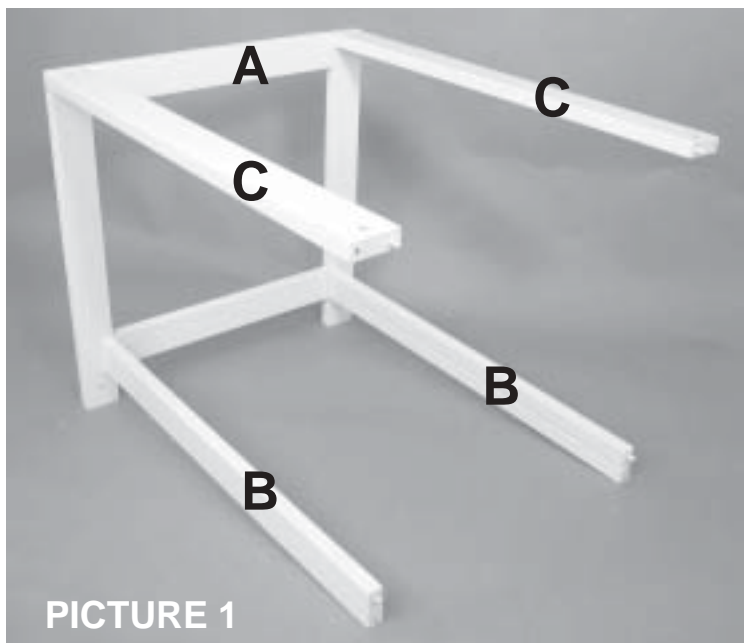

### CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Wipe bassinet clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent as needed. Bedding can be machine washed on cold, gentle cycle, and air dried or tumble dry on low or no heat. Iron on lowest setting for poly/cotton.



**STEP 1:** See **PICTURE 1**.

Take ONE END PANEL (A) and attach the TWO BOTTOM RAILS WITH GROOVES (B) using TWO WOOD SCREWS (D) (one screw for each rail).

Be sure the grooves are facing in so you can insert the bottom shelf later.

Attach the TWO TOP RAILS (C) to the same END PANEL (A) using TWO WOOD SCREWS (D) (one screw for each rail).

**STEP 2:** See **PICTURE 2**.

Take the BOTTOM SHELF (E) and slide it into the grooves on the BOTTOM RAILS (B) with the white side facing up.

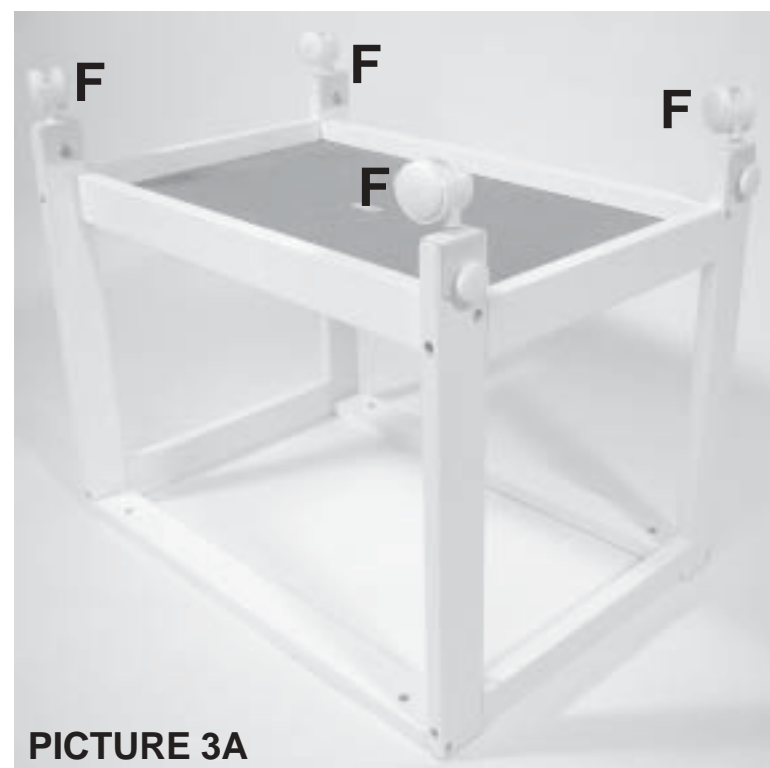
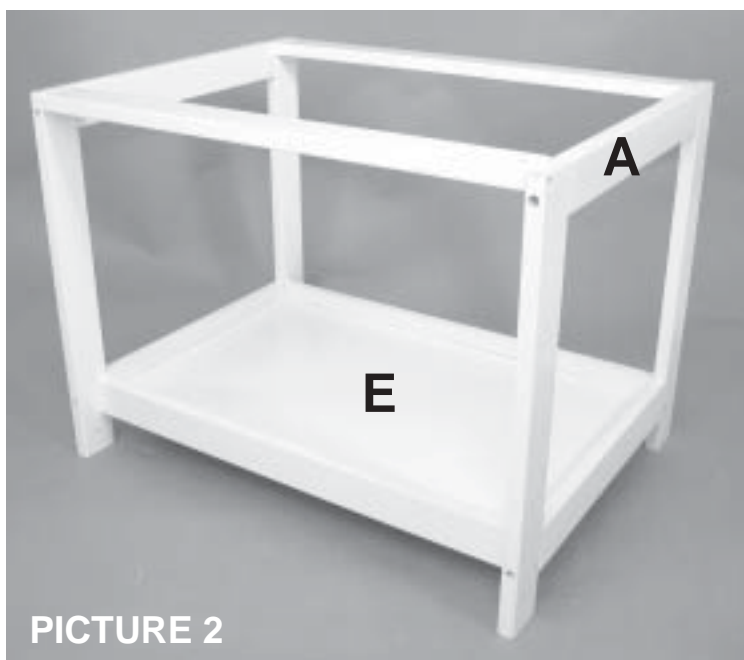
Attach the SECOND END PANEL (A) to the BOTTOM RAILS (B) and TOP RAILS (C) using the remaining FOUR WOOD SCREWS (D).

**STEP 3:** See **PICTURES 3A and 3B**.

Turn the bassinet stand upside down.

Attach ONE CASTER WHEEL (F) to EACH LEG of the bassinet stand using ONE BOLT and ONE NUT for each WHEEL.

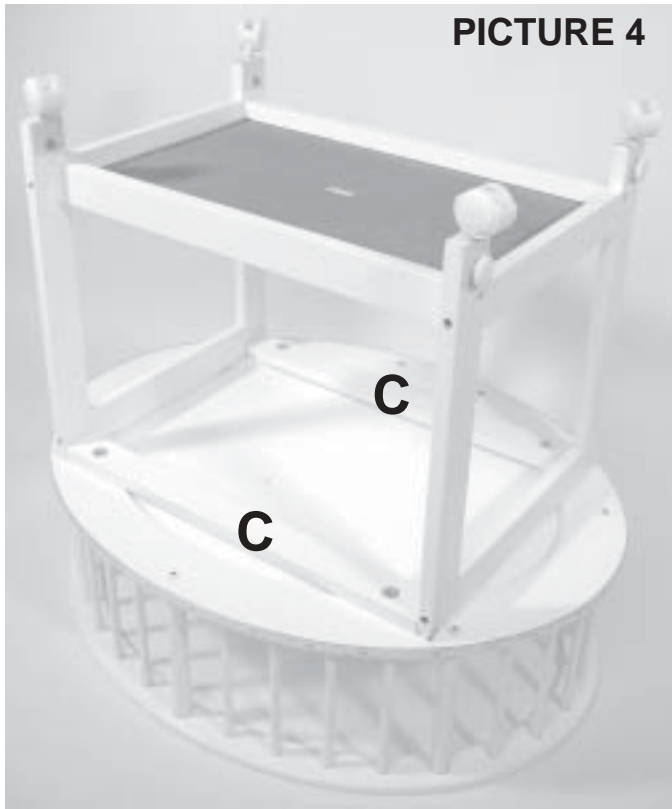
Tighten each wheel securely using pliers if necessary to turn the nuts. The BASSINET STAND is now assembled.

**STEP 4:** See **PICTURE 4**.

Locate the FOUR T-NUTS (G) and FOUR 1¼" BOLTS (H) so you can bolt the OVAL BASSINET BODY (I) to the BASSINET STAND.

This step is easiest to do if you put the oval bassinet body upside down on the floor, and then put the bassinet stand upside down on top of the bassinet body as shown in **PICTURE 4**.

Line up the four holes on the stand with the four holes on the body.

Insert the FOUR T-NUTS (G) into the four holes on the TOP RAILS (C).

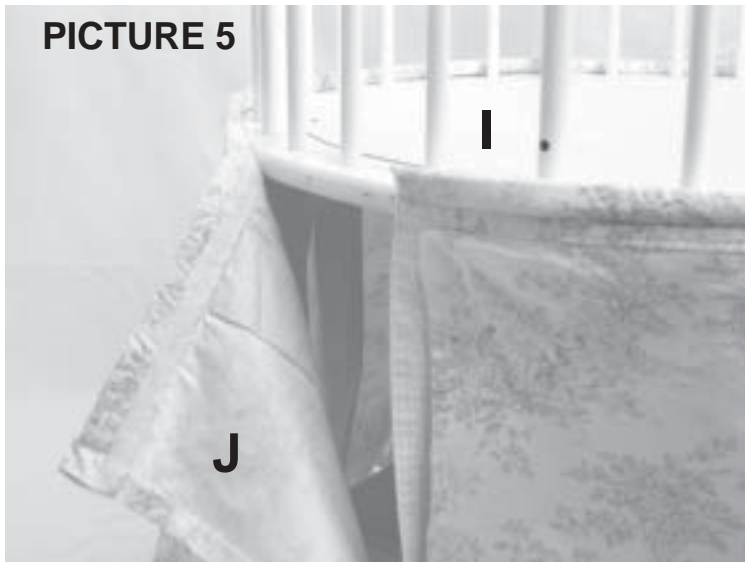
Then insert the FOUR 1¼" BOLTS (H) through the four holes on the OVAL BASSINET BODY (I) and securely screw them into the FOUR T-NUTS (G).

**STEP 5:** See **PICTURE 5**.

With the bassinet in its correct, upright position, wrap the FABRIC SKIRT (J) around the LOWER rim of the OVAL BASSINET BODY (I) pressing the grip tape strips together as you go around

Begin at the rear center where the metal spindle is located. The ends of the skirt will meet at the starting point and overlap.

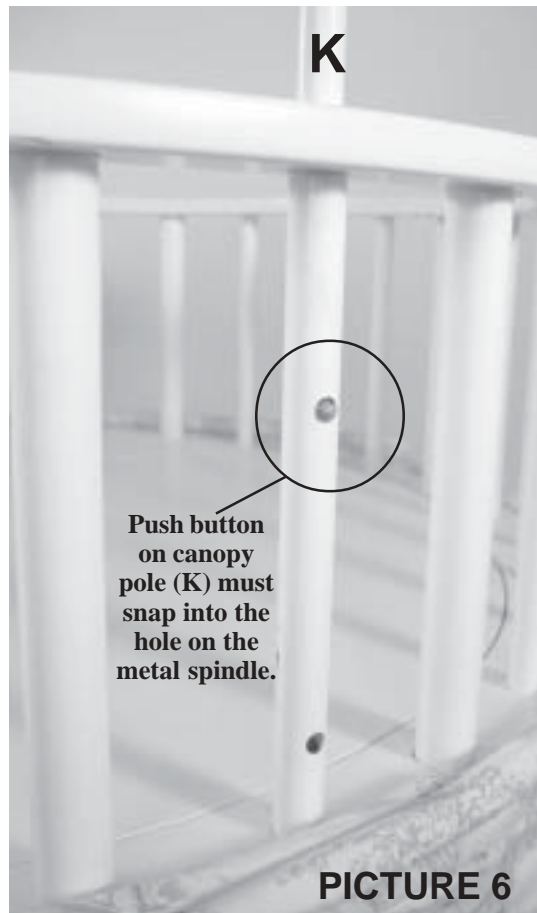
**STEP 6:** See **PICTURE 6**. **NOTE:** the METAL CANOPY POLE (K) has a slight curve/bend in it by design so that the canopy drapes properly over the bassinet.

There are two holes on the metal spindle on the BASSINET BODY (I) so that you can adjust the height of the canopy. Choose the height you want. Insert the METAL CANOPY POLE (K) into the metal spindle on the bassinet body (I), and snap the push button on the pole into the hole on the spindle. Make sure the canopy pole is held securely in position.

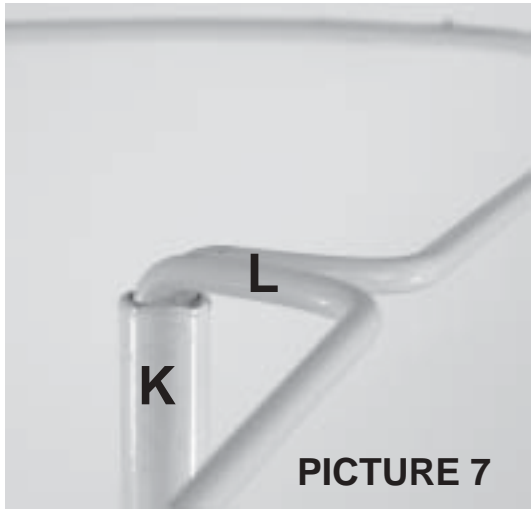
**STEP 7:** See **PICTURE 7**.

Grasp the two free ends of the CANOPY FRAME (L) and, holding them together, insert them into the top of the CANOPY POLE (K). Tap gently with a hammer until the ends of the frame are fully seated inside the pole. Next, place the FABRIC CANOPY (M) onto the CANOPY FRAME (L) and tie it to the frame with the ribbons.

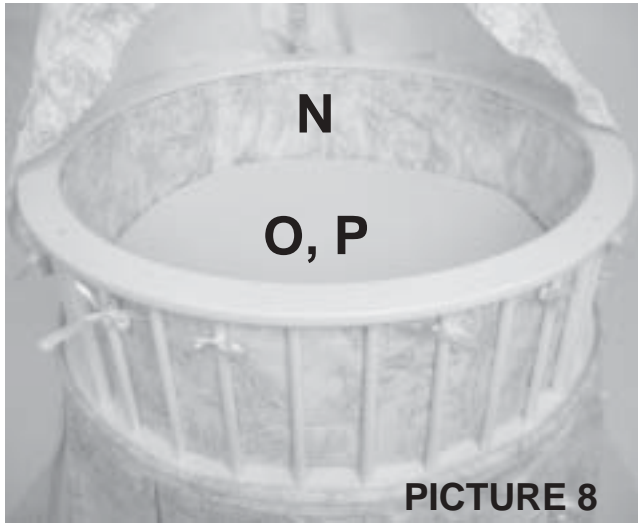

**STEP 8:** See **PICTURE 8**.

Position the **FABRIC BUMPER (N)** inside the **OVAL BASSINET BODY (I)**. Secure the tabs on the bumper to the thicker dowels and tie the ribbons, and then secure the remaining ribbons/tabs to the thinner dowels. **NOTE: Be sure the bumper is secured and check the ribbons regularly to make sure they stay tied. Loose bedding can be a danger to your baby, so it's very important to make sure the ties and fabric tabs are used properly to secure the bumper.**

**STEP 9:** See **PICTURE 8**.

Put the **FABRIC FITTED SHEET (O)** onto the **OVAL MATTRESS PAD (P)** and place the sheet and pad inside the bassinet. Additional sheets are sold separately (Model #00026)! Check our web site at [www.badgerbasket.com](http://www.badgerbasket.com) for more information or to find a retailer.

**STEP 10:** See **PICTURE 9**. Adjust the skirt and canopy so they are positioned to your liking. **Check ALL OF THE SCREWS, T-NUTS, AND BOLTS to make sure they are fully tightened. Carefully review the safety information below.**

**FALL HAZARD:** To help prevent falls, please note this bassinet is a safe place for your newborn to sleep until Baby is **4 months old, 20 lbs.** (9.09 kg), OR when Baby can **push up, roll over, or crawl** - **whichever limit comes first.**

- **SUFFOCATION HAZARD** - Infants can suffocate:
  - » in gaps between an extra pad and the side of the bassinet,
  - » on soft bedding.

NEVER add a mattress, pillow, comforter, or padding. Use **ONLY** the pad and/or bedding provided by the manufacturer. If a sheet is used with the pad, use only the one provided with the bassinet or one that is from Badger Basket Company or one that is specifically designed to fit the dimension of the the mattress provided.

- **TO REDUCE THE RISK OF SIDS:** pediatricians recommend that healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- **DO NOT** move or carry the bassinet with your baby inside of it.
- **DO NOT** allow other children or pets to climb into or onto the bassinet when your infant is inside.
- **DO NOT** attach or place toys with strings in or around the basket. Strings can cause strangulation or choking.
- **Keep bassinet away** from stoves, heaters, camp fires/flames, fireplaces, stairs, open windows, window blinds, running or standing water, and any other hazard which could cause injury to your baby.
- **NEVER** use plastic bags inside the basket such as to cover the mattress.
- **Bassinet should always** be placed on a firm, flat surface. It should never be placed near stairs or on tables or elevated surfaces.
