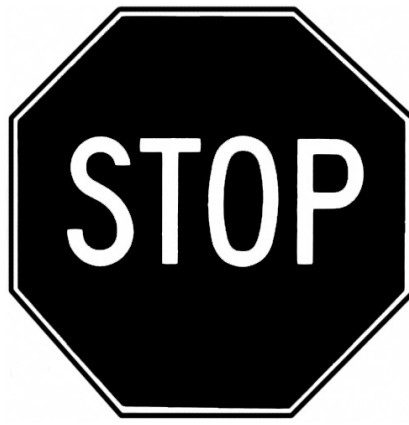

USE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Wipe the table, pad, and safety belt clean with a damp cloth and mild soap as needed. Dry thoroughly.

Spot clean baskets as needed. Do not immerse baskets in water.

Hamper bag can be removed for machine washing (cold water, tumble dry low or no heat or air dry).



WARNING

FALL HAZARD: Children have suffered serious injuries after falling from changing tables. Falls can happen quickly.


























- **STAY** within arm's reach of your child.
- **READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS** before use of this changing table.
- **DO NOT** use the changing table if it is damaged, broken, or missing any parts.
- The baby's **maximum weight** for use of this product is **30 pounds** (13.64 kg).
- This manual is part of the product. **KEEP INSTRUCTIONS for future use.**
- **NEVER** use the changing table without the safety belt properly installed.
- **ALWAYS** use the safety belt and keep at least one hand on Baby at all times.
- **ALWAYS** secure the changing pad to the changing surface by placing it onto the top shelf under the safety belt as shown in this manual.
- **This product is not intended to be used as a changing table without the top safety rails, changing pad, and safety belt installed.** Use of the product without this may result in death or serious injury to your child from falling. Follow all instructions on attaching and using the safety rails, changing pad, and safety belt.
- **NEVER** leave your baby unattended, not even for a moment, when you are changing Baby's diaper or dressing your child on the table.
- Product and/or hardware may include small parts or screws with sharp points.
Choking Hazard! Keep unassembled parts out of the reach of small children.
- Use only the changing pad, parts, and hardware provided by Badger Basket.
- **DO NOT** allow children or pets to climb on or play on the table.
- **Periodically check** to make sure all the bolts and screws remain tight and **regularly** retighten the bolts as needed.
- Keep child's skin/body clear of the safety belt buckle when snapping/unsnapping to prevent injury.
- Buckle is not securely fastened unless you hear an audible "click" to indicate the parts have connected securely together.
- If adjusting the length of the belt, always pull extra belt slack through the safety clip so that the belt lies flat.
- **NEVER** allow child to stand up on the table due to risk of falls and injury or death.



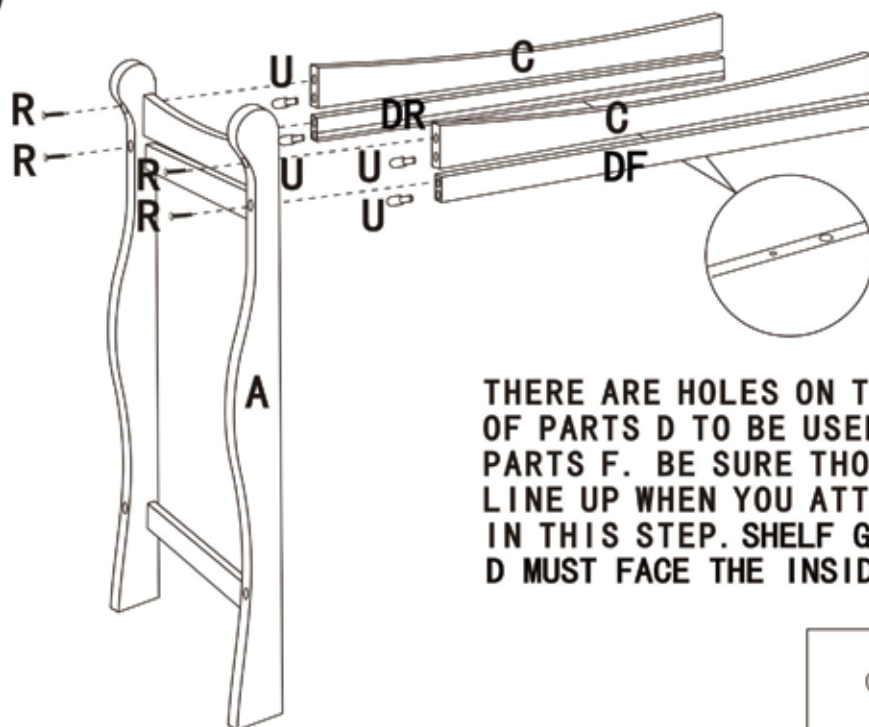

THERE ARE HOLES ON THE UNDERSIDE OF PARTS D TO BE USED IN STEP 2 FOR PARTS F. BE SURE THOSE TWO HOLES LINE UP WHEN YOU ATTACH THE RAILS IN THIS STEP. SHELF GROOVES ON PARTS D MUST FACE THE INSIDE.



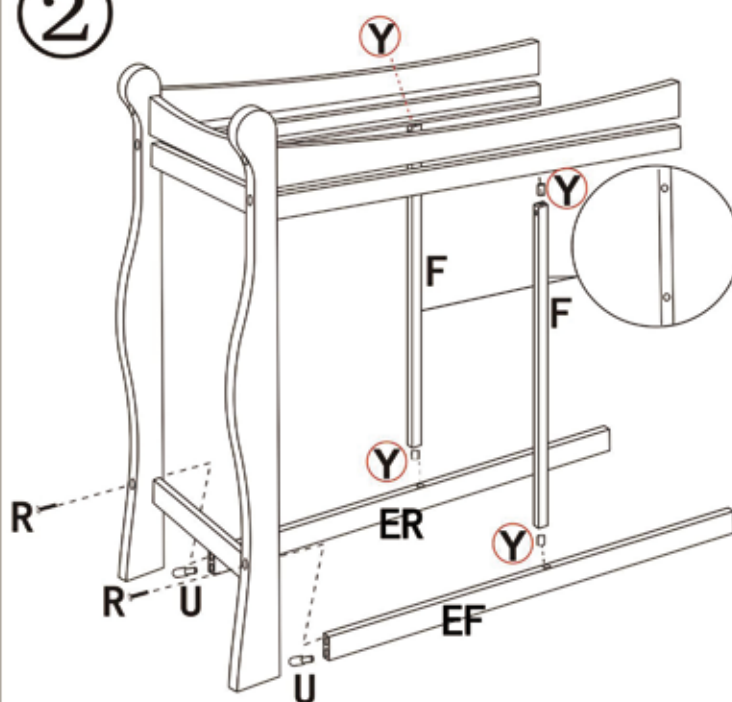

INSERT THE VERTICAL POSTS (PARTS F) INTO THE HOLES ON THE TOP AND BOTTOM RAILS (PARTS D AND E) BEFORE YOU ATTACH THE BOTTOM RAILS TO THE END PANEL (PART A). THE HOLES FOR THE POSTS ARE NOT CENTERED AND SHOULD BE POSITIONED CLOSER TO THE RIGHT SIDE PANEL (PART B THAT YOU WILL ATTACH IN THE NEXT STEP). ALSO, THERE ARE TWO HOLES ON THE LONG EDGES OF EACH PART F THAT MUST BE POSITIONED FACING PART B (WHICH YOU WILL ATTACH IN THE NEXT STEP).

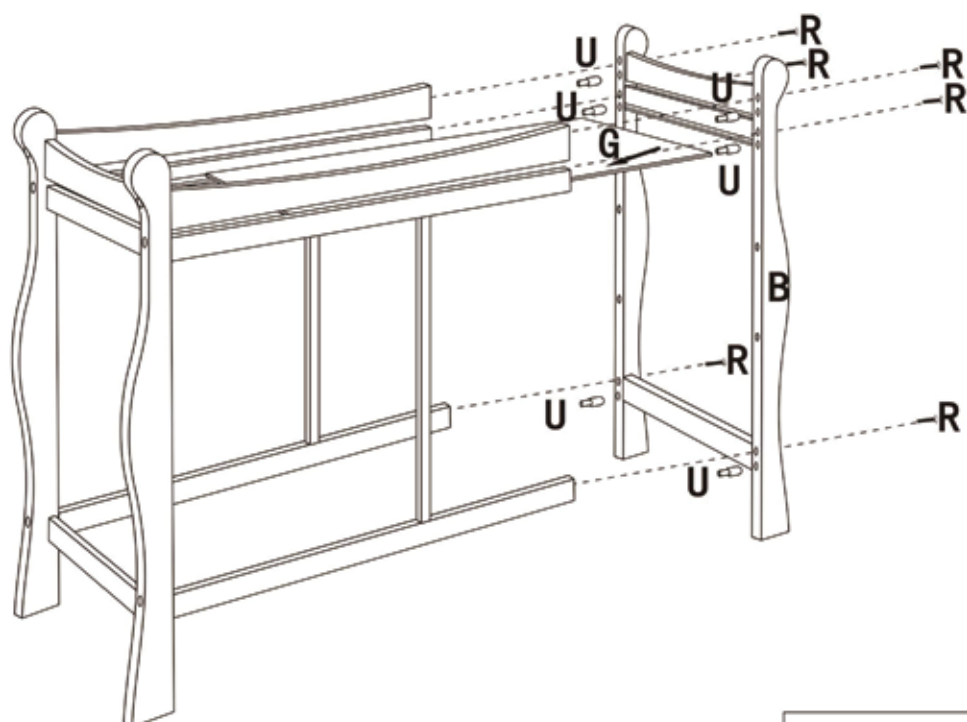

SLIDE THE SHELF PANEL (PART G) INTO THE GROOVES ON THE TOP SHELF RAILS (PARTS D) BEFORE ATTACHING THE RIGHT SIDE PANEL (PART B).



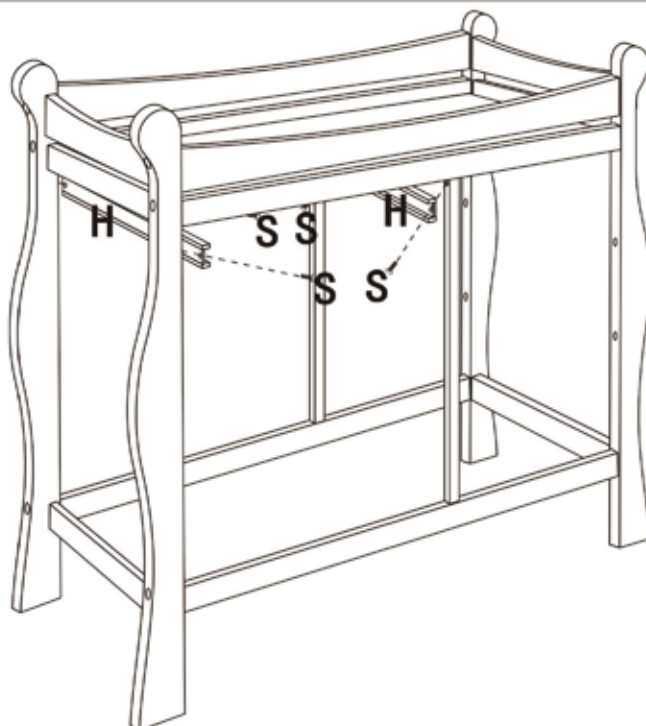

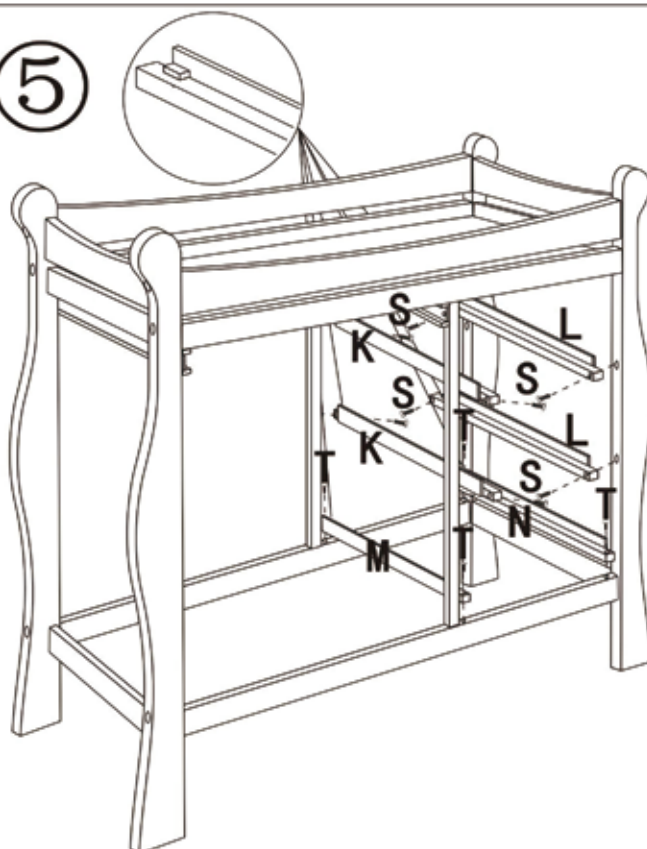
ATTACH THE HAMPER TRACKS TO THE LEFT SIDE PANEL (PART A) AND THE VERTICAL POSTS (PART F) MAKING SURE TO POSITION THE OPEN END OF THE TRACKS TOWARDS THE FRONT SO THE HAMPER GUIDERAILS WILL SLIDE INTO THE TRACKS IN STEP 9.

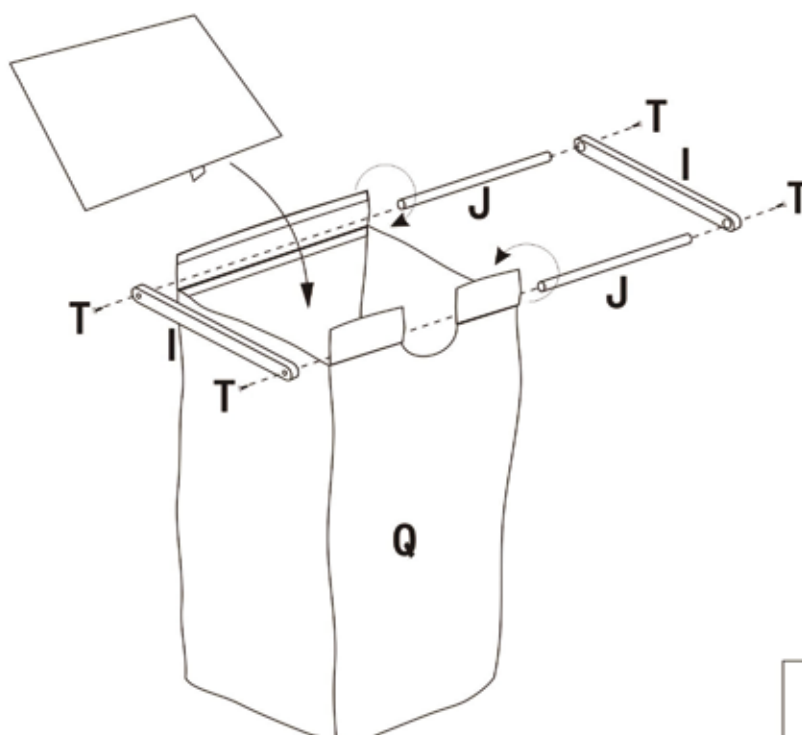
ATTACH THE TOP/MIDDLE BASKET TRACKS (PARTS K AND L) TO THE RIGHT SIDE PANEL (PART B) AND VERTICAL POSTS (PART F) USING PART S BOLTS. ATTACH THE BOTTOM BASKET TRACKS (PARTS M AND N) TO THE BOTTOM RAILS (PARTS E) USING PART T SCREWS.


THERE ARE DRAWER STOPPERS ON ALL OF THE K, L, M, AND N BASKET TRACKS WHICH MUST ALL BE POSITIONED AT THE BACK OF THE CHANGING TABLE.

PLACE THE CHANGING PAD (PART O) ON THE SHELF PANEL (PART G). SLIP THE ENDS OF THE SAFETY BELT (PART W) BETWEEN THE TOP RAILS AND TOP SHELF RAILS (PARTS C AND D). ON THE UNDERSIDE OF THE TOP SHELF, POSITION THE END OF THE METAL BAR (PART V) OVER THE ENDS OF THE SAFETY BELT AND SECURE IN PLACE WITH TWO OF THE PART T SCREWS AS SHOWN IN THE PHOTO.

BUCKLE CHILD SECURELY USING THE SAFETY BELT (PART W) WHENEVER CHILD IS ON THE TABLE. UNCLIP AND SEPARATE THE BUCKLE BY SQUEEZING THE TABS ON THE SIDES TO RELEASE THE BUCKLE TONGUE FROM THE BUCKLE. PLACE CHILD ONTO CHANGING SURFACE AND SNAP THE BUCKLE AND BUCKLE TONGUE BACK TOGETHER. KEEP CHILD'S SKIN/BODY CLEAR OF THE BUCKLE WHEN SNAPPING AND UNSNAPPING TO PREVENT INJURY. BUCKLE IS NOT SECURELY FASTENED UNLESS YOU HEAR AN AUDIBLE "CLICK" TO INDICATE THE PARTS HAVE CONNECTED SECURELY TOGETHER.

NEVER ALLOW CHILD TO STAND UP ON THE TABLE DUE TO RISK OF FALLS AND INJURY OR DEATH. NEVER USE THE TABLE WITHOUT THE SAFETY BELT (PART W) AND METAL BAR (PART V) IN PLACE.

ALWAYS SECURE THE CHANGING PAD TO THE CHANGING SURFACE BY PLACING IT ONTO THE TOP SHELF AND ENSURING THAT IT'S UNDERNEATH, NOT ON TOP OF, THE SAFETY BELT.
