No product is a replacement for adult supervision.

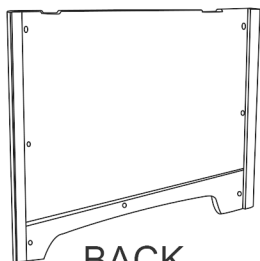
SAFETY HINGE LID SUPPORT MUST BE INSTALLED PROPERLY.

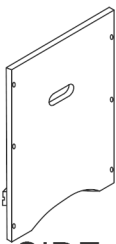
No maintenance or lubrication of the SAFETY HINGE LID SUPPORT is required.



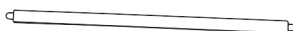

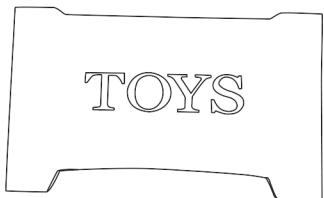

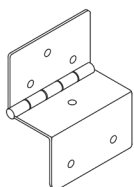

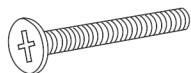


SAFETY HINGE

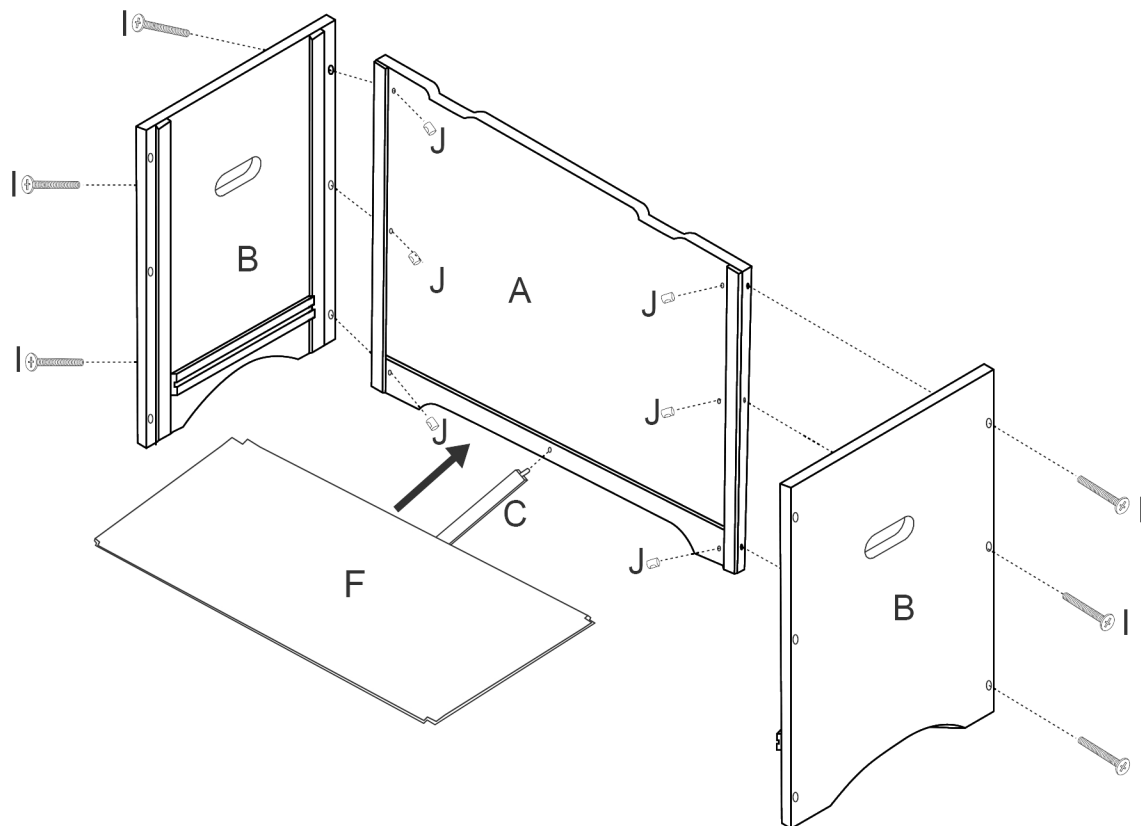

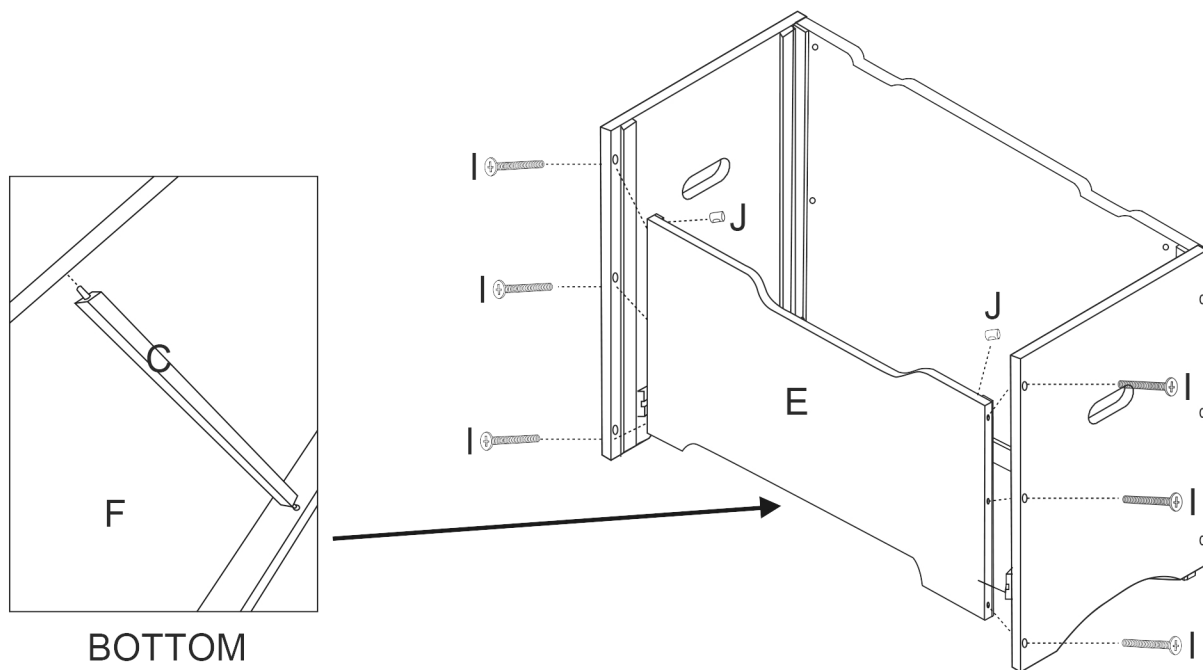

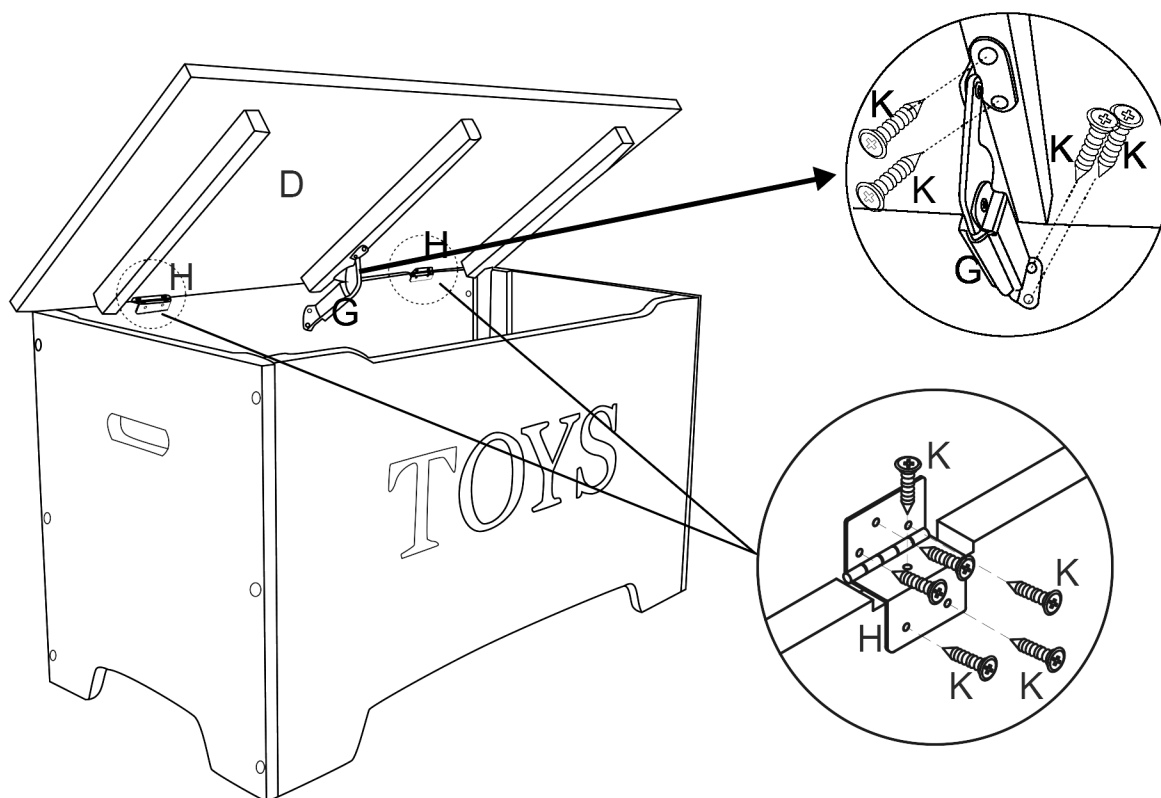
