(B) 2 - Large Wheel


(C) 2 - Small Wheel

(D) 1 - Pram Body


(E) 1 - Handle

(F) 1 SET - Hardware Kit (4xBolt, 4xSpacer, 4xCap Nut, Allen Wrench, Cap Wrench)

(G) 1 SET - Fabric Bedding (1xPadded Mat, 1xPillow, 1xBoot)



STEP 1: REVIEW THE FINAL ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM ON THE LAST PAGE OF THIS MANUAL FOR AN ASSEMBLY OVERVIEW. Attach the SMALL WHEELS (C) to the **shorter wheel posts** on the METAL CHASSIS (A). Attach the LARGE WHEELS (B) to the **longer wheel posts** on the METAL CHASSIS (A). Push the metal bracket at the center of the wheel inward to open it (PHOTOS 1 and 2), slide the wheel onto the end of the post, and release the bracket. The bracket locks over the tip of the rod, and if you tug on the wheel it should not come off.

STEP 2: Attach the PRAM BODY (D) to the METAL CHASSIS (A). Line up the four hinges on the CHASSIS with the four brackets on the BODY, and snap them in (PHOTOS 3 and 4). The **canopy end** of the BODY (D) attaches on the SMALL WHEEL (C) side of the CHASSIS (A).




PHOTO 3 - Line up the Hinge






PHOTO 4 - Snap into place



STEP 3: Attach the HANDLE (E) to the PRAM BODY (D) using the HARDWARE KIT (F) (FOUR BOLTS, FOUR SPACERS, FOUR CAP NUTS, ALLEN WRENCH and CAP WRENCH). Align all the parts as shown in PHOTO 5.






STEP 4: Place the PADDED MAT and PILLOW (G) inside the PRAM BODY (D). Attach the BOOT (G) to the outside of the PRAM BODY (D). The BOOT (G) has elastic loops that stretch around the spindles on the BODY (D), and also snaps that snap to the canopy.



STEP 5: The canopy can be fully open with the hinges locked to keep it up, or unlock the hinges and fold it flat.

FINAL ASSEMBLY:



(A) Metal Chassis (B) Large Wheel (C) Small Wheel (D) Pram Body (E) Handle (F) Hardware (Bolts, Spacers, Cap Nuts)

(G) Fabric Bedding (Padded Mat, Pillow, Boot)
