### USE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Wipe storage unit clean with a damp cloth and mild soap as needed. Dry thoroughly.

Do not use acidic cleaners (such as vinegar). Spot clean baskets as needed.

Do not immerse baskets in water. Some soft plastic/rubber toys (such as balls) can react with and cause damage to the finish when left in prolonged contact.

Be mindful of what is stored in the unit and regularly check toys and the unit to prevent damage.

CAREFULLY TIP THE UNIT ONTO THE FRONT EDGE BEFORE ATTACHING A – LEFT SIDE.






